The Vietnam Veterans For The Community Goals and Core Values As An Organization:

Vietnam Veterans For The Community, Inc. was formed in late 2004, and incorporated in the state of Massachusetts, and recognized by the Internal Revenue Service as a 501c3, non-profit, charitable organization in February of 2005.

The group consists primarily of veterans who served in Vietnam or its territorial waters, although membership is open to anyone who served a minimum of 90 days active duty in the Armed Forces of the United States during the Vietnam-era (1955-1975) and was Honorably Discharged.

The group was organized exclusively for charitable, educational and scientific purposes.

Scholarship Criteria:

The Vietnam Veterans For The Community will be selecting high school seniors who exemplify a competitive GPA (3.0 or higher); standing out as a lead members of the **Leicester High School** graduation class of 2024, placing their community and civil duty as young adults above themselves, as members of the forever changing 21st century.

This year's scholarship will be in the awarded amount of \$500.00 intended to support the graduating senior class who will be attending a -2 or -4 year collegiate university setting starting in the Fall 2024.
